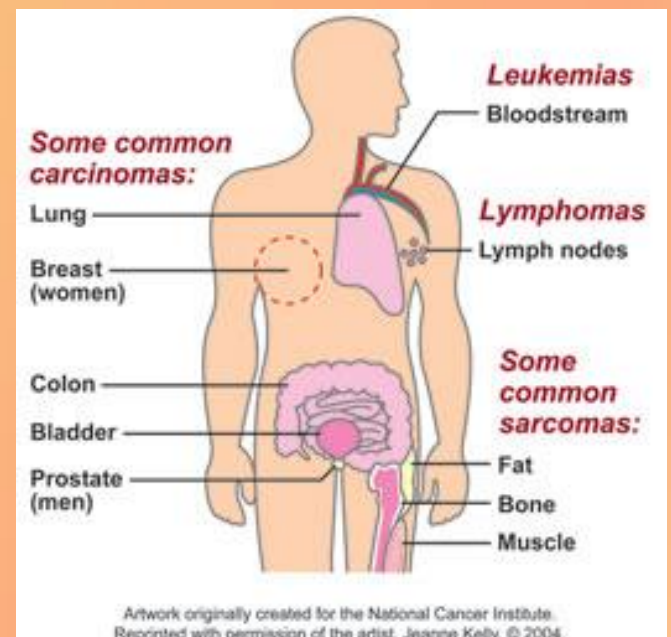
Be clear on cancer: Signs and symptoms of common cancers

Associate Consultant, Department of Haematology-Oncology, National University Cancer Institute, Singapore (NCIS)
Dr Thomas Soh obtained his medical degrees from the National University of Singapore and the Royal College of Physicians, United Kingdom. He later completed his advanced specialist training in Medical Oncology at the National University Hospital.

His interests include treatment of patients with gastrointestinal (GI) and hepatobiliary cancers as well as end of life care for terminally ill cancer patients.

He is the principal investigator in several multi-centre GI cancer clinical trials, and was twice awarded the National Medical Research Council Clinician Investigator Salary Support Program (CISSP) Award from 2010 to 2014.

In addition, he is also the Honorary Secretary of the Singapore Society of Oncology currently.

He is actively involved in education and is part of the Core Faculty of both the Internal Medicine Residency and the Senior Residency program in Oncology in NCIS.
