Muhammad Tani Tabiin

Tani has over 25 years' experience in product development and technology commercialisation. While at A*STAR, Tani and his team managed more than 100 Tech development projects worth \$110Mil with an 85% success rate. Spun off more than 30 A*STAR BMS companies and closed more than 300 licenses. Tani then joined a group of scientists from one of the projects that he had managed, developing miRNA based early stage cancer diagnostics, to form MiRXES and served as CBO/COO for almost 4 years before joining TLA.

Tanuja has a PhD in immunology and now works as a Launch Entrepreneur-in-Residence at Entrepreneur First. This means she personally works very closely with resident founders and teams throughout the programme, helping them find co-founders, ideate, and scale their product in just 6 months. She also has experience building her own startup before this.



Benjamin Reinhardt

Ben is an Entrepreneur-in-Residence at Entrepreneur First where he mentors entrepreneurs through the process of forming teams and building businesses. Previously, he has worked in venture capital and started two companies. He also worked on machine learning and product at Magic Leap, and did research at NASA. Ben has a PhD in Space Robotics from Cornell, and studied medieval history and aerospace engineering at Caltech.
